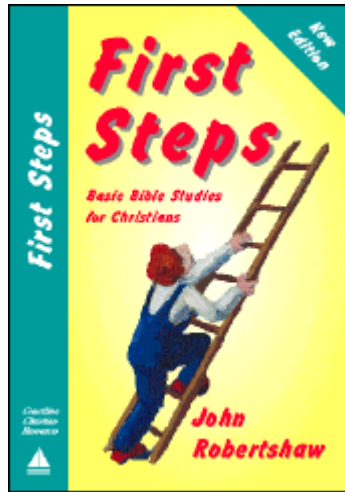

One praise and prayer item. Praise that I've finished the work that Patricia had for me on the 5 booklets, the need now is for Patricia to learn how to use Paratext. This is a Bible Society tool, a wonderful one, I used it for the half NT. Patricia will be having help learning it from one of our fellows in Brazil - but he is not a translator, so he'll be learning it too. For many years people and organizations set up their own ways to write accented letters. This has changed, and everyone is encouraged to go over to Unicode. My stuff was all in the old system, as was Paratext. The new version of Paratext uses Unicode. So I'll be working on putting all translated materials into unicode in Paratext to help Patricia get set up with it. I'd value prayer that we'll be able to get this sorted for her this month.
